

JEXCA House Becomes a Reality: A Dream Fulfilled at Jolshiri

Date: June 29, Venue: Jolshiri Project, Purbachal, Time: Noon



On 29 June 2025, JEXCA achieved a historic milestone with the successful completion of procurement of land for its own premises, JEXCA House, at the Jolshiri Project, Purbachal, and the registration was completed on 10 November 2025. The due installment payments were made from the funds raised through members' contributions, while the remaining amount was drawn from the JEXCA Endowment Fund FDR, as approved in the EGM held on 20 June 2025. This remarkable achievement reflects the unity, dedication and vision of the JEXCA fraternity in fulfilling a long-cherished dream.

JEXCA EMERGENCY GENERAL MEETING 2025

Date: June 20, Venue: Amana Food Ville, Mohakhali, Time: Evening



The Emergency General Meeting (EGM) of JEXCA was held on Friday, 20 June 2025, at Amana Food Ville, Mohakhali, Dhaka, with both physical and Zoom attendance. The meeting, chaired by President Prof. Dr. Borhan Uddin Khan, saw participation from 137 members in person and online. With the permission of the President, Professor Borhan Uddin



Khan, General Secretary Mr. Galib Mohammad welcomed all members and read out the official EGM notice and agenda under Clause 14.03 of the JEXCA Constitution. Mr. Galib Mohammad provided a brief overview of the Jolshiri Housing Project, highlighting the urgency to complete the payment by 30 June 2025, and then invited the President to formally preside over the session. Having met the required quorum, the President called the meeting to order. A central focus was the urgent need to complete payment for the JEXCA House land at Jolshiri Project. The President and EC proposed using BDT 1 crore from JEXCA's Endowment Fund FDR to meet the immediate deadline, as contributions alone could not cover the shortfall in time. After several discussions, Ex President Md. Nasser Shahrear Zahedee (6/315) clarified EC's stance of using FDR as an investment. Ex President Lt. Gen Mohammad Mahfuzur Rahman (rtd.) (10/618) proposed that "Encashment of BDT One Crore from existing FDR of Endowment Funds" be approved for completion of Jolshiri Land procurement which was seconded by Syed Sajjad Hayat (3/99) and was unanimously approved by the General Body. During the miscellaneous session, it was decided that both College Day (23rd July), marking the start of academic activities, and Foundation Day, commemorating the laying of the foundation stone, would be observed separately in future. The Annual General Meeting (AGM) was announced for 15 November 2025, to be followed by a Mezban at CCCL, Purbachal, with all members encouraged to attend. Additionally, the Back to College Program was scheduled for 2nd-3rd January 2026, requiring a minimum subscription of BDT 10,000 per participant. To manage accommodation, it was decided that the last six passed-out intakes would not be eligible for this event. In closing, the President expressed gratitude for the unity and generosity of the JEXCA family, emphasizing that the success of the Jolshiri project stands as a testament to collective strength and shared ownership. The meeting concluded with a dinner and renewed determination to shape JEXCA's future together.



JEXCA TRIUMPHS AS CHAMPIONS IN EXCAM CRICKET 2025

The winning project, titled “Stellar Sanctuaries: Orchestrating Effervescent Health with Celestial Garden,” stood out among hundreds of international submissions for its innovative approach to food security, resource optimization, and sustainable waste management in extraterrestrial environments. A brilliant team of six present cadets worked tirelessly over the past year to develop their concept, showcasing extraordinary creativity and scientific insight. Their achievement has elevated the name of JCC and Bangladesh on a global platform. Inspiration for this success came from JCC’s newly established robotics lab, Automatos 27, built with the support of JEXCA. The competition drew 9,028 participants from 1,641 institutions across 11 countries, competing in 7 major categories and 21 sub-categories. Focused on health and wellness solutions for orbital, lunar, and Martian colonies, the challenge encouraged futuristic thinking and sustainability. The cadet team traveled to the United States for their presentation, where they were warmly received by JEXCA North America President, Mohammad Hasan Iqbal (13).
